

2026 Online Auction Donation Guidelines

We're expanding our annual Online Auction (1-15 November) to include gift hampers as well as original art and fine jewellery. This popular fundraiser supports all our centres and services around WA.

We appreciate donations according to the following guidelines:

- **Gift hamper** donations can include gift certificates from businesses for services and products, and commercially produced consumables such as gourmet food items and luxury toiletries in unopened condition and with long best-before dates.
Please note that we cannot accept home-made consumable items.
- **Artworks** must be original or authorised reproductions with family-friendly themes and are displayed in our centres until they are sold. Artworks can be of various mediums, including watercolours, oils, acrylics, pencils, pastels, and photography canvases, as well as sculptures and ceramics. We prefer that the artist has signed the work and/or can be named, and we appreciate any further information about the piece that the donor can provide.
Please note that we cannot accept mass-produced items or unframed paintings/sketches/photos.
- **Fine jewellery** may include gold or sterling silver, pearls, precious and semi-precious stones. We also appreciate quality handmade jewellery of materials such as dichroic glass, polymer clay, leather, etc. Details about the materials, designer/creator (if applicable) and suggested values are greatly appreciated.
Please note that we cannot accept mass-produced/costume jewellery.

Most donated items will be included in the current auction. However, PPH staff may hold some items for inclusion in future auctions or events to ensure a balance of pieces on offer to our supporters.
